

Dance Concert Photo FAQ's

Who will be taking the photos (and where)?

- Edward Crim of Edward Crim Photography takes the photos at My King Studio.
- Forms of payment accepted: Cash, Checks written to "Edward Crim Photography" and Credit Cards

When are the order forms due?

- The MKS Front Desk accepts completed forms - with payment - at any time prior to or the day of photos.
- We strongly encourage you to make your decisions regarding packages, etc. before arriving at the studio on photo day.

For students who would like to have an individual photo taken -

- Fill out the photo form and turn it into the Front Desk with payment in order to have an individual photo taken.
- We only take individual photos of students who have turned in a form with payment.

For students who would like one individual photo taken and additional group photos of other classes -

- Fill out the top portion of your form.
- Choose a package - A, B, or C.
- On the lines near the bottom, write in the classes for which you would like additional group photos.

For students who would like more than one individual photo taken -

1. Fill out one form per individual photo.
2. You must purchase at least one package.
3. If you would like additional individual photos and would like these as a non-package/add-on item, you may do that, but you still must complete steps 1 & 2.

For sibling/family/friend photos -

- If you would like to purchase an "individual" package with more than one person - i.e. sisters, cousins, best friends, etc., you must fill out the top of the form with EACH person's name at the top.
- Let the Front Desk know, and they will properly note your form for Edward Crim.

Are parents allowed in the room during photos?

- Students of all ages do great without parents and family members in the room during photos.
- For sure, we will call a parent in for a student if needed.

How long do the photos take?

- Because we are photographing so many students in such a short amount of time, we have a posing system down and can get a class photo along with 8+ individuals easily during the time slots, as long as all of the students are present and ready for photos on time.
- Sometimes, if we are waiting on a student to arrive, photos may take a little longer than the allotted time.

Will I be able to see my photos before purchasing them?

- Edward Crim does not offer the option to view photos prior to purchase.
- He takes fantastic photos, though, and if you are unsatisfied with your photos, please contact him directly, and he will work it out with you.

How early should I arrive for photos?

- Arrive at MKS 15 minutes prior to your scheduled picture time with you dancer dressed and ready to go.

When will I receive my photos?

- Photos will be available for pick up at MKS beginning the end of May.
